- 2008 Evergreen Brick Works is awarded an **Acknowledgement prize** at the second **North American Holcim Awards** competition for sustainable construction. Evergreen received \$20,000 USD towards the implementation of the Evergreen Brick Works project. The Holcim Awards is an international competition of the Holcim Foundation for Sustainable Construction. The competition seeks innovative, future-oriented and tangible sustainable construction projects; offers prize money of \$2 million USD per three-year competition cycle; and is run in cooperation with renowned partner universities: Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), USA; Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH Zurich), Switzerland; Tongji University, China; Universidad Iberoamericana, Mexico; and the University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa.
- 2007 Geoff Cape, executive director, Evergreen, wins the prestigious **Schwab Foundation's** "Canadian Social Entrepreneur of the Year" Award, Canada's top social entrepreneurship honour. Through this award, Cape joined an esteemed network of social entrepreneurs drawn from 26 countries worldwide who together addressed some of the world's biggest social, environmental and economic problems.
