Indigenous Land Connections





Explore land-based learning with an emphasis on inquiry-based approaches that honour Indigenous Ways of Knowing.

Guided by Indigenous Seasonal Teachings, participants will learn strategies to support learners in connecting to the land in all seasons and spaces. As the seasons shift, so too can our activities, drawing inspiration from the changing landscape and exploring the many ways nature can heal and nourish our minds and bodies.

Tailor your experience by **choosing** <u>two</u> of the following three sessions:

1. Walk the Land

- Guided hike focused on fundamentals of landbased learning
- Deepen connection with the land through walking and exploration
- Observe seasonal changes and reflect on our relationships with land and learning

2. Work the Land

- Explore Indigenous land stewardship and urban agriculture practices
- Hands-on experience caring for a traditional Indigenous garden (Gitigaan)
- Learn traditional planting, harvesting, and care techniques

3. Learn with the Land

- Gather in the
 Strawberry Heart Lodge
 (Ode'imniwiigamig) with a
 Fire Keeper
- Engage with cultural teachings and protocols
- Reflect on ways to meaningfully incorporate Indigenous Ways of Knowing into educational and professional settings



Indigenous Land Connections — What to Expect

Opening Circle (30 min)

Begin in a Good Way. Establish protocols and set intentions for our shared experience. Smudging and a welcome address help establish a sense of respect, connection, and mindfulness as we embark on the learning journey together.

Session 1 (70 min)

Deepen connection to the land. Whether walking, working, or learning with the land, this session encourages experiential, inquiry-based exploration that supports Indigenous Ways of Knowing and connection to place.

Break (10 min)

Take a breath. Recharge, reflect, and prepare for the next session with renewed focus and energy.

Session 2 (70 min)

Explore from another perspective. Build on insights from the first session, and continue your journey. This opportunity enriches understanding and offers a holistic view of land-based learning.

Closing Circle & Gratitude (30 min)

Bring learning full circle. Come together to share reflections, express gratitude, and ask final questions. Foster a sense of closure and commitment to carrying learning forward.


